

Residents and Fellows,

The MedStar Graduate Medical Education Committee (GMEC) currently has an opening for **three** resident representatives and is in search of a residents/fellows that are interested in becoming an active members of the Committee. Responsibilities include:

- Supporting the house staff in system, institutional and performance improvement activities
- Being an advocate for the house staff - listening to concerns and addressing issues as appropriate
- Serving as a link for relaying important communication to/from house staff
- Serving as a voting member of the MedStar GMEC

The winners will be elected based on peer votes, with consideration given to hospitals that currently have no resident representation on the committee (current representatives are from MWHC). In accordance with ACGME rules, at least two residents must be present at all meetings. Attendance should be coordinated ahead of time by the elected officers and communicated to the GME staff. If an elected officer is unable to fulfill his/her obligations, (s)he will be removed from the position and a new officer will be elected. This is a **2 year position**; applicants must be entering the upcoming academic year with at least 2 years of residency/fellowship training remaining.

- Prepare a brief personal statement outlining your interest and commitment to this position. Your statement will be distributed to the house staff for voting purposes.
- Be enrolled in an ACGME-accredited residency or fellowship program
